

Requirements for the Knoxville Ebony Network HBCU Scholarship Amount: \$500

Student must be a current graduating high school senior from an accredited high school in East Tennessee.

Student must submit the application postmarked no later than the last date in April of the current year.

Student must have a 2.5 Cumulative GPA (Jr. & Sr. year)

Student will be attending any accredited Historical Black College or University.

Student is in need of financial assistance.

Student must submit a one page typed essay titled: "(The importance of continuing the LEGACY of Historically Black Colleges and Universities.) Student must make sure to include on a cover sheet the student's name, address, phone number, a high school transcript, a teacher recommendation letter and a graduation or recent photo.
